

## **Regional Orientation Workshop to be conducted on 27 august 2018 in Marathi Vidnyan Parishad, Mumbai.**

The information relating to the captioned workshop is furnished below:

1. The workshop will be from 10 A. M. to 4.00 P. M on 27 August 2018 in Marathi Vidnyan Parishad(MVP) , Mumbai. The address of the venue of the workshop is as under:

2. There are no registration charges for the workshop.
3. The registration for the workshop will commence from 9.00 A. M on the day of workshop and the Breakfast will be available, free of cost at the time of registration.
4. The eligibility criteria for the participation in the 9<sup>th</sup> NTSC has been laid down in the Brochure of the workshop. The workshop will be conducted for the eligible Teachers and Educators from the States of Goa, Gujarat, Maharashtra and Rajasthan.
5. The persons of the State of Maharashtra having their place of residence in Mumbai and Navi Mumbai and from where (place of residence) the venue of workshop can be reached by local trains i. e. Virar, Karjat and Panvel on Western railway, Central railway and Trans Harbor railway respectively, will be treated as LOCAL PARTICIPANTS and will not be eligible for accommodation facility.
6. All participants other than those indicated in sr. no. 4 above will be treated as outstation participants and the accommodation facility will be available to them for a maximum of one (1) day, i.e. either in the night of 26 August 2018 or 27 August 2018.
7. **No reimbursement of travelling expenses (whether local or long-distance journey) will be made to any participant, whether local and outstation.**
8. Breakfast, working lunch, tea & snacks will be provided to all the participants free of cost on the day of workshop and the dinner will be provided free of cost to the outstation participants availing the accommodation facility on 26.08.2018.
9. The participants need to shortlist at least one subtheme and bring along a short write up of the topic they wish to work on, at the workshop.
